2021 APPLICATION PROCEDURES

All Scholarship Applicants must:

- Be a resident of one of the following Georgia counties covered by the Metropol by-laws: Fulton, DeKalb, Gwinnett, Coweta, Fayette, Clayton, Henry, Rockdale, Newton, Douglas, Paulding, Cobb, Cherokee, or Forsyth
- Indicate which of the available scholarships they qualify for. (Chosen applicants will receive only one scholarship.)
- Be a 2021 high school graduate, unless applying for the Continuing Education Scholarship with Study in Criminal Justice / Corporate Security Fields
- Be accepted to / enrolled in a two- or four-year institution of higher learning (Proof of actual acceptance / enrollment is required)
- Submit an official transcript. (For current high school seniors, the transcript must include grades 9-11 and the first semester of grade 12. For college students, transcripts should include all college courses). The transcript must cite the cumulative grade point average and must be signed by a school official with the official school seal in a sealed envelope (DUE TO COVID-19, EMAIL TRANSCRIPTS WILL BE ALLOWED, SENT FROM THE SCHOOL. PLS EMAIL TO KAREN.GRANT@GBI.GA.GOV.)
If the applicant attends a school that uses a non-traditional grading system, an explanation of that school's grading system must be provided on official school letterhead.
- Submit (1) one current (2020/2021 school year) signed letter of recommendation from a *non-school related community service or job (volunteer or paid) activity* that you participated in on the organization's letterhead (DUE TO COVID-19, EMAIL LETTERS WILL BE ALLOWED, SENT FROM THE AUTHOR. PLS EMAIL TO KAREN.GRANT@GBI.GA.GOV.)
- Submit (1) one current (2020/2021 school year) signed letter of recommendation from the *school (i.e. teacher, principal, counselor, etc.)* currently being attended on official school letterhead (DUE TO COVID-19, EMAIL LETTERS WILL BE ALLOWED, SENT FROM THE AUTHOR. PLS EMAIL TO KAREN.GRANT@GBI.GA.GOV.)
Persons writing either recommendation letter should specify their relationship with the applicant or the capacity in which they know or have observed the applicant.
- Submit a typed essay detailing past accomplishments and future goals. (**One page - maximum**)
- Sign the application and have it signed by a legal parent/guardian
- Have the application signed by a (DUES PAID) Metropol member for 2020-2021

Scholarship finalist will be contacted and asked to provide their DOB/SSN with the understanding that a criminal history check will be performed. Those with a history will not be considered.
